## **FLPC pilgrimage to the Holy Land in 2021 with Rev Brackenridge as Leader.**

We plan to travel 16<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> November 2021. In November things are much less busy and generally not too hot or too cold. When I was there in late Nov. 2018 the temperature ranged from 16-23c I propose a 10 day programme with two days taken up with travel. To give you some idea of cost, the 10 day programme with say, British Airways connecting flights from Belfast to Tel Aviv via London Heathrow in about £2,225 per person sharing. Dublin to Tel Aviv is also a possibility. This price includes all travel.

In Jerusalem we stay at the three star Golden Walls Hotel overlooking the Old City walls, within walking distance of the Holy Sepulchre. In Tiberias, we stay at the four star Ron Beach Hotel in a wonderful situation right on the lakeside. The tour is on a full-board basis with buffet breakfast, lunch and evening meal included daily.

Touring is by our own private air-conditioned coach and we will be accompanied by a local guide who will share leadership responsibilities and look after the formalities of hotel check-ins, etc. All entrance fees are included as well as gratuities.

Days are busy but we will try to limit walking to an agreed amount in any one session. Evenings are free for relaxing together. If you are interested in joining the group please let me know as soon as possible. JB.
